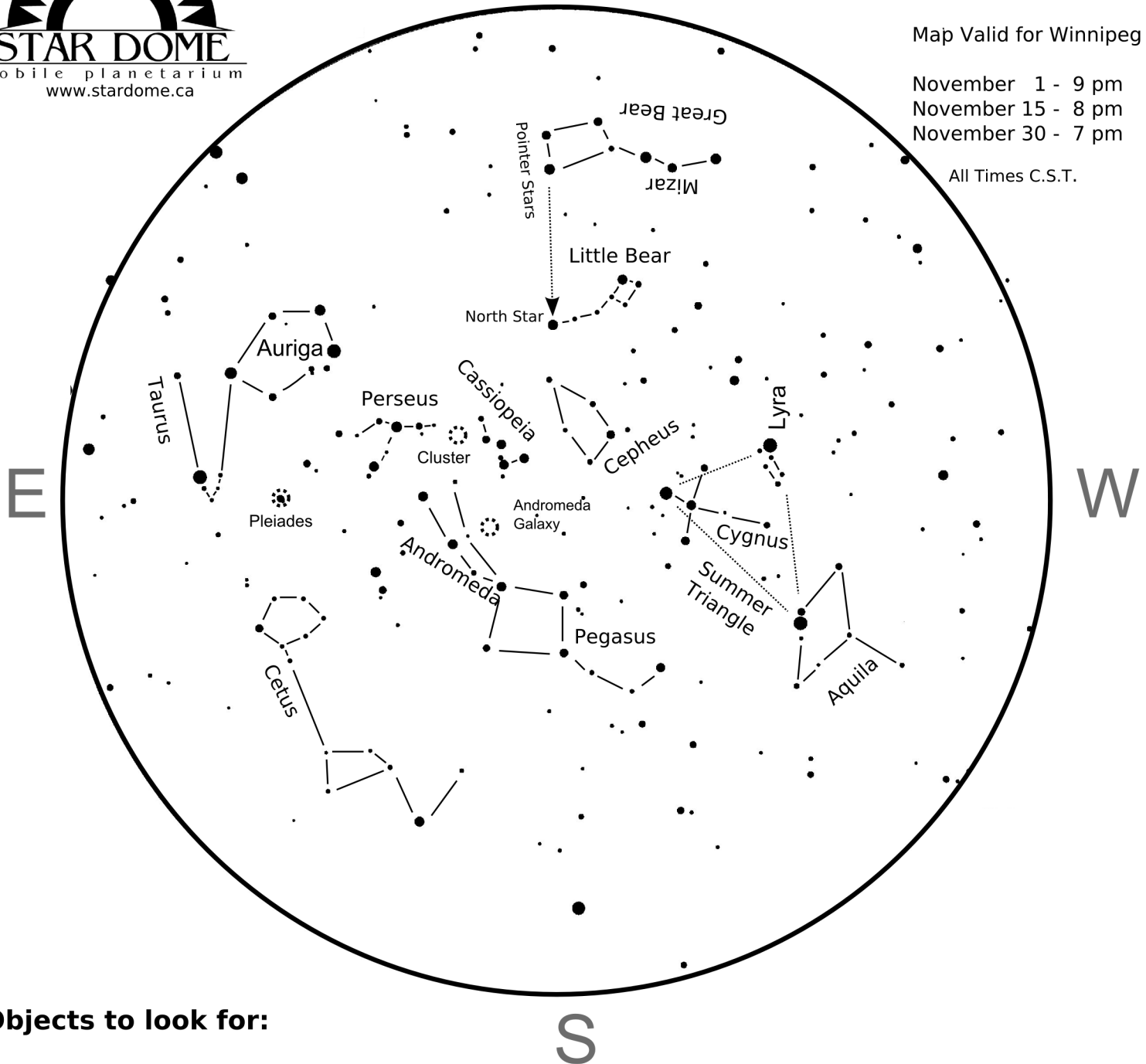

Objects to look for:

Pleiades Star Cluster - Also known as the seven sisters.

Cluster between Cassiopeia and Perseus - Can be seen with the naked eye in dark skies as a small faint misty patch. Good object for binoculars as well.

Andromeda Galaxy - Can be seen with the naked eye from dark country skies. This is the furthest object you can see without a telescope. Light from the Andromeda Galaxy took over 2 million years just to reach your eyes. It appears as a large misty oval in binoculars.

Mizar - Can you see the faint companion star to Mizar? This star is called Alcor. It looks like a tiny fleck right next to Mizar. It is easier to see with binoculars. Mizar itself is made up of 4 other stars all orbiting each other but are so close together you can't see them as separate stars even with binoculars. Just think that when you are looking at Mizar and Alcor, you are looking at a family of 5 stars, not just the two you can see.
