## **Grade 1 – Daily and Seasonal Changes**

The Star Dome show "Daily and Seasonal Changes" is designed to address a number of specific learning outcomes in the Grade 1 science curriculum unit 4 (Daily and Seasonal Changes).

	Specific Learning Outcomes
1-4-01	Recognize that the Sun is a source of light and heat.
	Take a closer look at the sun in the planetarium dome
	Show the relative sizes of the planets to the Sun
1-4-03	Recognize that a day is divided into day-time and night-time based on the presence or absence of sunlight.
	• See how the Earth spins and that day/night is related to this motion
	Show that all planets in our solar system spin and experience day and night
1-4-05	Recognize that shadows are caused by blocked light.
	Examine the phases of the moon
1-4-06	Observe and describe how the Sun appears to change position over the course of a day.
	Watch the daily motion of the Sun across the sky – starting from its rising in the eastern part of the sky to its setting in the western part of the sky
1-4-09	Compare characteristics of the four seasons.
